God does miracles together with us. When Noah acted on God's word, God moved. Do not be just a hearer, be a doer (Gen. 6:22; James 1:22-25).



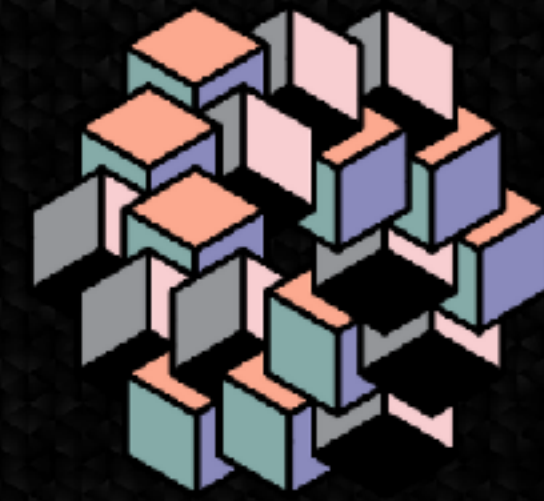
